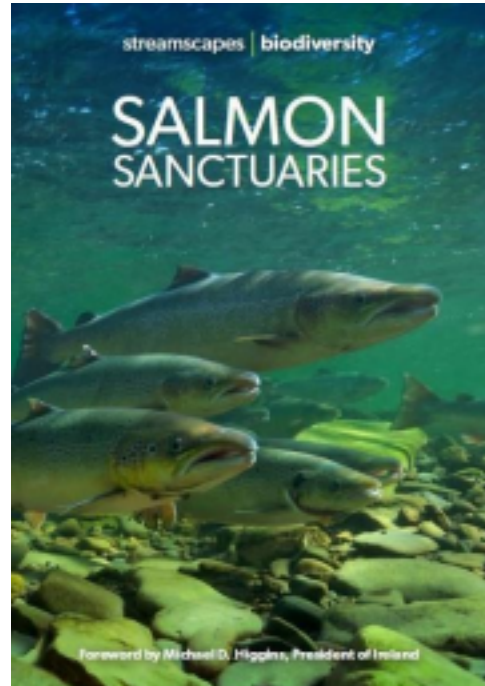
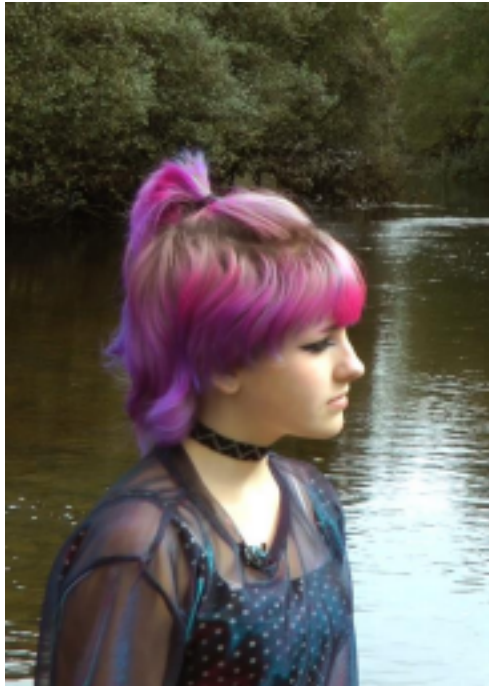


Salmon Sanctuaries Course
